GENERAL WOODCUTTING PERMIT CONDITIONS:

1. Permits can be issued for a maximum of one (1) month and only one (1) permit will be issued for any segment or area at any one time.
2. Permits are not transferable and payment is not refundable.
3. A maximum of 3 cords may be cut and removed per issued permit. Wood is to be used for personal use only.
4. Permission is given to cut and remove downed trees only. No standing trees (alive or dead) may be cut under this permit. In some instances park staff may cut down a problem standing tree for cut up and removal under this permit.
5. Cutting and hauling is to be done using chain saws, axes, or other hand tools and pick up trucks/trailers. The use of tractors, skid steers, dump trucks or other heavy equipment or machinery are not authorized under this permit. Work shall not take place when the potential for trail surface or other property damage is likely due to wetness or soft conditions.
6. Cut or uncut wood remaining onsite at expiration of the permit reverts to County ownership. Permit expiration date will not be extended.
7. Dodge County Parks may cancel or revoke this permit by oral or written notice upon breach of any condition or restriction of it. Such breach may also subject the violator to prosecution.
8. Dodge County Parks may cancel, revoke, suspend or postpone issuance of this permit by oral or written notice due to safety, damage, environmental or other concerns.
9. The permittee recognizes the applicability of section 895.52, Wis. Stats., and agrees to protect, indemnify, and save harmless the Dodge County Parks and Dodge County Parks employees and agents from and against all causes of action claims, demands suits, liability or expense by reason of loss or damage to any property or bodily injury to any person, including death, as a direct or indirect result of operations under this permit or in connection with any action or omission of the permittee, who shall defend the Dodge County Parks and Dodge County Parks employees and agents in any cause of action or claim.
10. Permit shall be prominently displayed in the windshield of vehicle or shall be kept with the permittee when in the work area.
11. Brush shall be stacked with butt end toward trail or other location accessible by wood chipper maintaining a minimum 2' clearance from edge of trail or traveled way.
