## 2016 Section 5310 Grant Application highlights For the Transportation Advisory Committee

Dodge County will be submitting a 2016 5310 grant for the purpose of obtaining a new van. The grant request will be for a two (2) wheelchair van. This van will be used to replace van 952 which was recently sold.

We presently have only one two wheelchair van. This van is used not only for rides where there are two wheelchairs, but for riders who require a wide wheelchair. The wide wheelchairs do not fit into the minivans. With only having one available van for the wide wheelchairs, we often have to turn trips away. The addition of another two wheelchair van will also allow us to combine rides. For example, if we have two rides going to Madison, we presently will take two minivans. If the rides are within a close timeframe, we could take both rides in the two wheelchair van. This would free up a driver and a vehicle to do additional rides.

We received the grant application on June 22, 2015 with an application deadline of August 28, 2015. The grant awards will be announced in fall.

This grant allows us to purchase a van for an estimated 20% of the cost of the van. This is a huge savings to the transportation program. Once the grant awards are made, the state puts out a bid for the vans. Grant recipients are contacted as to specific van details such as the color.
