Air dry liquid latex paint in the can by removing the lid. To speed up this process, mix oil dry, cement, plaster of Paris or kitty litter with the paint. Once dried, dispose of the dried paint/can with household garbage.

- Used Motor Oil

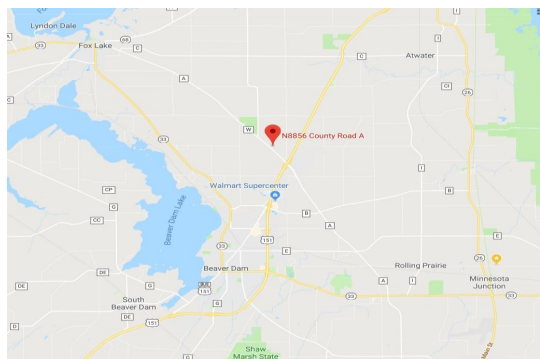

Clean Sweep Guidelines

- Residents of Dodge County are eligible to participate
- Materials should be properly identified with their original labels
- **DO NOT MIX** materials together
- Pack materials for your safety
- Pack containers in the trunk of your vehicle, away from people
- Unknown materials can be brought in, but Dodge County and its hazardous waste disposal contractor reserve the right to refuse any material



What is Clean Sweep?

Clean Sweep is a collection of unwanted, unused or damaged agriculture or household hazardous waste. This program collects and disposes of waste in an environmentally safe method through a licensed hazardous waste facility. Hazardous waste can usually be identified by product labels that contain any of the following words:

Caution, Warning, Danger, Poison, Toxic, Ignitable or flammable, Acid, Corrosive or Reactive.

Pre-Registration is required for Agriculture & Very Small Quantity Generator Business Collection (VSQG)

A VSQG is a small business that generates less than 2,205 lbs. of legally defined hazardous waste.

Agriculture Products—Farmers can dispose of their Ag chemicals for free.

Small Business—will receive a quote after Pre-Registration

Pre-Register—by calling Dodge County UW-Extension at 920-386-3790 between 8am and 4:30pm, Monday through Friday.

ONLY phone reservations accepted.

Register before August 16, 2019

Be prepared to estimate the amount of material being brought to the location (pounds of dry and gallons of liquid).
