Sheriff Schmidt provided an overview of action taken by the Dodge County Executive Committee on August 8, 2019 regarding a waiver to County Board Rule #37 – New Position Requests for the upcoming budget year. Through the waiver, the proposed new positions for the Sheriff Office will be presented to the County Board at the September 17th meeting.

Sheriff Schmidt provided an oral summary of the proposed positions.

- Abolish one full-time jail corporal and create two jail sergeants
- Create one full-time deputy secretary
- Abolish one full-time deputy sheriff and create one full-time patrol sergeant
- Create two part-time (less than 20 hours) court security deputies

Sheriff Schmidt also provided an update to the previously postponed Resolution (April 2019) to abolish detective and create patrol sergeant.

No action taken – the Resolutions will be considered by the Judicial and Public Protection Committee at a future meeting.

As no further business was before the Committee, Chair Miller declared the meeting adjourned.
