- Outreach: The Aging Unit participated in outreach activities including a booth at the Dodge County Fair. The Benefit Specialists will be assisting consumers with access to benefits during the annual Medicare open enrollment period from October 15 through December 7.
- Evidence Based Prevention: In partnership with the Beaver Dam Community Hospital, a class for Stepping On will be held from October 3rd – November 14th at Stone Terrace.

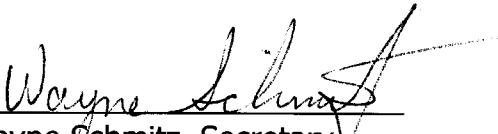
Next Meeting
